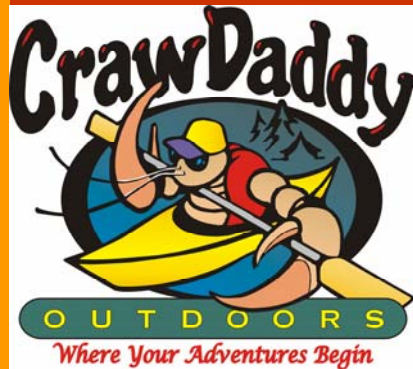

WIND RIVER RANGE

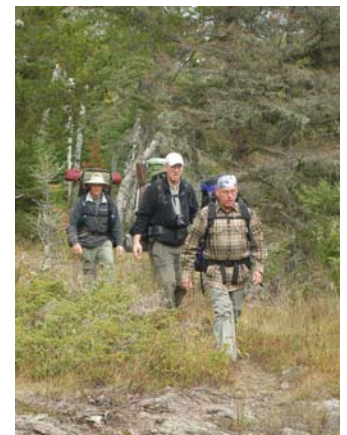

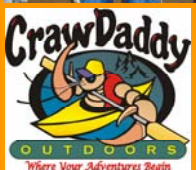

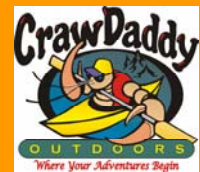
SEA KAYAKING LAKE SUPERIOR AND THE APOSTLE ISLANDS

A valid Iowa fishing license is required and is not included in the fee.

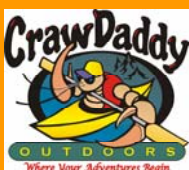
